Dear Parishioners

May I bring to your attention one or two items of 'parish housekeeping':

Much work has taken place in the Pastoral Centre over recent months (and much money!). If you have not yet visited the main hall please do have a look at the transformation that paint, new upholstery and new chairs, as well as the new curtains, have brought about. The kitchen too has a few extra facilities. We shall have to have a party to celebrate! Please pass on the good news and encourage people to use the Centre for their celebrations.

Stuart Irving has been involved with the Pastoral Centre for over 20 years. He has now retired but I would like to thank Stuart for all his dedicated work. We wish him well in his retirement. I am pleased to announce that Steve Adams-Duff has accepted the job of P.C. Caretaker.

Locks have now been put on the interior doors of the Parish Centre. Those who use the rooms regularly have been issued with the codes but if anyone else requires access please contact St Anne's parish office.

Over the past three years we have had to spend over £10,000 on resurfacing parts of the Pastoral Centre Car Park. Our insurance company has insisted that repairs should be made. The car park is for the use of those attending church services and using the Pastoral Centre, and dropping off and picking up from our schools.

Increasingly, however, people are parking in the morning and leaving their cars till evening – some even parking overnight – and so causing problems for those with a legitimate reason for parking. We shall try to get the word out, but it may be necessary on occasions to close the car park. Please be aware of the signs that will give notice of this. We have also looked at the possibility of engaging a company to 'man' the car park, bearing in mind those who have a good reason to park there, but at the moment we don't propose going down that line. If you have any suggestions about the car park I am very happy to hear from you. Many thanks to you and all those who work so hard as volunteers to look after our grounds.
