Dear Parishioners

At Pentecost last year Pope Francis spoke about the Spirit who 'transforms the hearts of timid disciples from fearful men huddled behind closed doors to bold men who bear witness to Jesus'. Pope Francis continued: 'The action of the Holy Spirit frees hearts, impels service, guides people in new directions and makes the lukewarm thrill to new dreams. That is what it means to change hearts. The Holy Spirit provokes change so that we can turn to Him for a "powerful jolt" when we are in need of real change. The Spirit transforms the hearts of the timid disciples from fearful men, "huddled behind closed doors", to bold men who "bear witness to Jesus" (Jn 15:27). His action frees hearts, impels service, guides people in new directions, and makes "the lukewarm thrill to new dreams. That is what it means to change hearts", Pope Francis said.

**'Come Holy Spirit, come into my heart,
come into my day.**

**Jolt me into recognizing the power of your love
and change me to become the person you wish me to be.'**
